### **Exodus: The LORD who leads and guides his redeemed people**

- The question at the center of the exodus story: "\_\_\_\_\_ is the \_\_\_\_\_?" (5:1-2)
  - "The Egyptians shall \_\_\_\_\_ that I am the LORD, when..." (7:5)
  - "I am the LORD your God, who brought you \_\_\_\_\_..." (20:1-11)
  - "The LORD, the \_\_\_\_\_, a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness..." (33:18-34:9)
- At the center of it all, the song Moses and the people sang on the shores of the Red Sea (15:1-18)

- What was the LORD looking for as he led his people? \_\_\_\_\_ (Heb 11:22-29).

  - "The founder and perfecter of our faith..."
