NEWS FROM ROME (ITALY)

Rome, February 11, 2026

Dear brethren in Christ

my wife Antonella and I hope to find all of you doing just fine, in every spiritual and material God's blessing. We would like also to express to you our deep feelings of gratitude for the opportunity given to preach the power of the gospel also in a Catholic city as Rome, in badly need of knowing God's Word. Biblical ignorance is so dominating our society that it's getting harder and harder to find honest hearts in searching of Truth. Very sad but also a strong challenge to keep on with our preaching.

PERSONAL NEWS. We are doing well, thanking God: no big physical problems to deal with. Our three grandchildren (Alessandro 11, Alice 9, Samuele 6) are growing well at the same time. They are always very busy with their daily activities, between school and sport practices. We are trying day by day to be of some help for our daughter Valeria, taking and keeping them around.

Our son Paolo is also doing fine. He is of great help in the church local work, growing in responsibility and activity. He must be an example for the other young brethren, in order to build up together a solid foundation for future work.

LOCAL PREACHING ACTIVITY. Our local activity is continuing well, in spite of some "old" problems that once in a while come back as a consequence of the Marco De Martino's abandoning of the faith. He is now in fellowship with liberal people, after having lost all his reputation among Italian churches. I remain vigilant and careful, after having touched his serious dangerousness. Again, courage, patience, sound teachings are the good "weapons" of our spiritual fight.

I am trying to direct my general teaching to the fundamental attitude to build a sound personal responsibility within Christ's body: different people walking toward one only goal. Some are working and growing faster than others, but the importance is to march together with no distractions.

I'm always real busy in the personal Bible classes teaching with the brethren. Good fruit is coming: Bible awareness, sensitivity, active participation, spiritual mind vision.

The Chinese group is still attending with nice attitude and sincere sense of respect. New faces are coming in and some others

moved out of Rome for jobs. The language barrier is managed through different translator apps and so the communication with the group is doing better.

During the midweek class on Wednesday, I am still commenting John's gospel: we reached chapter 19.

Our general attendance runs around 35 (including the few brethren that still join us at distance through Zoom).
