While the concept seems simple, the application and implication have opened the

door for false concepts and conclusions. Calvinists teach what is called "double imputation."

First, our sins were imputed to Christ on the Cross

Second, Christ's perfect righteousness is imputed to believers at conversion.

So, when God sees us, He sees Jesus' perfect life in us.

A. Genesis 15:1-6 (Heb 11:8-9) **Why was Abraham considered RIGHTEOUS?**

- What was put in the ledger book?
- This was not Abraham's first step of faith (Gen 12:1-2; 13:14-17; 14:19; Rom 4:20-24)
- What we do not find is a transfer of character, ignoring personal obedience or Christ's life credited to someone else

B. Rom 4:7-8 **Why does God not impute sin?**

- does not mean the Lord ignored the sin, or sin doesn't matter

Imputation describes the result of forgiveness—the books are changed


If Christ's moral character is imputed to us:
