## NEWS FROM ROME (ITALY)

### Rome, March 10, 2026

Dear brethren in Him,  
my wife Antonella and I hope to find each one of you doing well, in all the wonderful spiritual blessings from God. We would like to share with you again our sincere feelings of thankfulness for all you are doing in our behalf, to make possible our preaching of the gospel also in a difficult spiritual field as the city of Rome is. We are daily surrounded by Bible indifference and human traditions against God's will. Our challenge in Rome is not to be overcome by those external influences but to keep on speaking about God's greatest things with faithfulness and renewed passion.

**PERSONAL NEWS.** We are doing fine, thanking God. We continue to have regular control medical checks, and all seems to go well. Our three grandchildren (Alessandro 11, Alice 9, Samuele 6) are always around us and this is a joy for us. They are growing too fast, though. We hope to be of some help to them when difficult moments will come. Our modern societies are filled with dangers and wrong attitudes.

Our son Paolo is also doing OK. He is doing fine in his secular job and within our local church. Something very important for us.

Everyone here in Europe is obviously quite worry and sad about the rumors of war coming from different areas. We can already see some economic consequences of the recent events, besides the loss of young and old people. Gasoline reached \$ 9.5 per gallon, and so all other products (as a domino effect) raised their prices. Especially alimentary goods are going up and up. I hope that the situation may soon get better. I am really perplexed and don't understand much of the news information that are passing day by day. Surely, it is a delicate and critical historical moment.

**LOCAL PREACHING ACTIVITY.** Our local work is doing fine. Some heavy problems (caused by the Di Martino family, that after sadly destroying the Ciampino work, now joined liberal churches and ideas!) are slowly moving away and we can view at the future with a clearer mind and right serenity. The church is deeply united and firm in the Truth. Bad experiences lived in

the church in some way help people to get closer to the Lord. When we use the spiritual “weapons” given by the gospel (courage, patience, endurance, sound teachings) things can only follow God’s righteousness.

I’m particularly working with young group of the church, helping them to put spiritual things in the right perception. They are growing very well, with the encouragement of all the brethren.

As I already wrote in past reports, I am directing my principal teaching efforts to the capacity to build a sound and autonomous personal responsibility within Christ’s body: different people that walk hand by hand to reach together the final and glorious goal. Some are doing better than others, naturally, but important is to live in the view of a together attitude and pattern.

I’m always busy in the personal weekly Bible classes with some brethren. I see evident good fruit out of it, especially a mature awareness of God’s knowledge.

The Chinese group is still attending with good attitude and respect. New people came in while some others moved out of Rome for job needs. At first, girls were in majority number, but now I see several new men attending and making questions. The language barrier is still managed through translator’s apps. The situation seems to get better.

During the midweek class on Wednesday, I am still commenting John’s gospel: we reached chapter 20.

Our general attendance runs around 35 (including the few brethren that still join us at distance through Zoom).
