NEWS FROM ROME (ITALY)

Rome, April 14, 2026

Dear brethren in Christ,
my wife Antonella and I hope to find all of you doing fine in every spiritual blessing. We would like to express again our deep feelings of gratefulness for your support that allow us to preach the gospel also in a pagan city as Rome, so dominated by human traditions and false religious teachings. In spite of all this, we are striving to give our best in proclaiming God's Word. We always hope to find good and honest hearts, willing to follow only what the Bible teaches.

PERSONAL NEWS. We are doing well, always thanking God. Good health and good medical checks. Our three grandchildren (Alessandro 11, Alice 9, Samuele 6) are often with us and this is a joy for grandparents. We help them to do homework's and sport activities, trying to help our daughter Valeria to carry on the daily burdens.

Our son Paolo is also doing fine. When he is off from work, he is a firm source for the local work of the congregation. Thinking about the future of this work, his growth is significant and very important.

We are seriously worried about the rumors of war that are coming from different areas. Economic consequences of all this are already part of our daily problems. Every good and life necessities are increasing day by day, especially price of gasoline that today went a little over 10 \$ per gallon. We hope in better days and in a more illuminating decisions by major governments. This is a really critical historical moment.

LOCAL PREACHING ACTIVITY. Our local work is proceeding well. The brethren are close and united in one mind, as the N.T. teaches to accomplish. This is always a delicate edge and for this we must practice constant vigilance and zeal.

I'm still particularly involved with young group of the church, trying to set the priorities of life. We do personal weekly Bible classes together and they are responding well with the encouragement of all the congregation.

The Chinese group is doing fine. New people are attending to our services and their attitude it is always of great respect and interest. The language barrier is still a problem for some of them, but translators are giving a big hand. Some of them are striving to solve their visa problems, but we are trying to help in what we can.

During the midweek class on Wednesday, I finished the comments on the gospel of John and soon I will start the study of Ephesians and Colossians.

Our general attendance runs around 35 (including the brethren that sometime join us at distance through Zoom).
