PERSONAL NEWS. Thanking God, we are all doing very good. Our three grandchildren (Alessandro 11, Alice 10, Samuele 6) are doing just fine but growing too fast. We do what we can to help our daughter Valeria to take care of the daily duties. They are quite busy in this last part of school program.

Our son Paolo is also doing well. With the summertime coming, he's much busy with his job, due to the beginning of vacation season. In the free time he's helping in the local work of the congregation, growing in many things. He could be one of the future sources to carry on the work done so far through many years.

The economic consequences due to the results of different fields of war are still very heavy and we all hope that soon it may be finally over.
