# Questions God Asks

**To read before class:** John 8

How does John 8 fit into the larger story of Jesus and the Gospel of John? Big-picture-wise, what's going on?

What signs can we see in John 8 that Jesus is the “all-knowing God” we’ve been talking about throughout this study?

In 8:10, Jesus asks a woman two simple questions: “Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?” Why? Why would an all-knowing God ask questions like that?

- ❖ What does this interaction tell us about Jesus?
- ❖ What does this interaction tell us about the scribes, the Pharisees, and the woman?
- ❖ Most close to home, what impression should this interaction make on us?
